

# PETITION TO THE HOUSTON ACRES CITY COMMISSION

Rumble strips installed on Houston Boulevard, April 17, 2026

To the Mayor and Commissioners of the City of Houston Acres:

The residents listed in this petition signed the statement set out below. Each signer lives on the affected block of Houston Boulevard or on an immediately adjoining property.

THE STATEMENT SIGNED

"We ask the City Commission to follow through on the engineer review, include affected residents, and replace the rumble strips with a quieter traffic-safety solution."

Ten households on the affected block have signed. One additional household has abstained owing to a stated conflict.

## HOW THESE SIGNATURES WERE COLLECTED

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Signatures were collected online at QuietHoustonAcres.org between June 8 and July 9, 2026. Each signer submitted their name, home address, and email address through a form on that site. Records of each individual submission, including the date and time received, are retained and can be provided to the Commission on request. No signature was solicited door to door, and no signer was offered anything in exchange.

## WHAT THE SIGNERS ARE ASKING

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### 1. Follow through on the engineer review.

Identify the engineer or firm engaged, the scope of the review, and the date by which findings are expected. At the June 25, 2026 meeting the Commission stated that this could be undertaken without a vote.

### 2. Include affected residents.

Provide a means for residents of the affected block to submit firsthand observations to the reviewer — times of day, vehicle types, and the noise and vibration experienced inside our homes — and release the written findings publicly.

### 3. Replace the strips with a quieter traffic-safety solution.

We support the Commission's objective of slowing traffic on Houston Boulevard. We ask that it be achieved by a means that does not impose continuous noise and vibration on the homes alongside the road. Other municipalities have made this substitution, and the Federal Highway Administration describes discontinuing rumble strips near residences as accepted agency practice.

We raise this as neighbors, not as adversaries. We do not suggest the Commission acted in bad faith. We ask only that the review already promised be carried out, and that its findings guide what happens next.
